Pollak holds a Masters Degree in Fine Arts from Michigan State University with Post Graduate studies from the Center for Creative Studies in Detroit, MI.

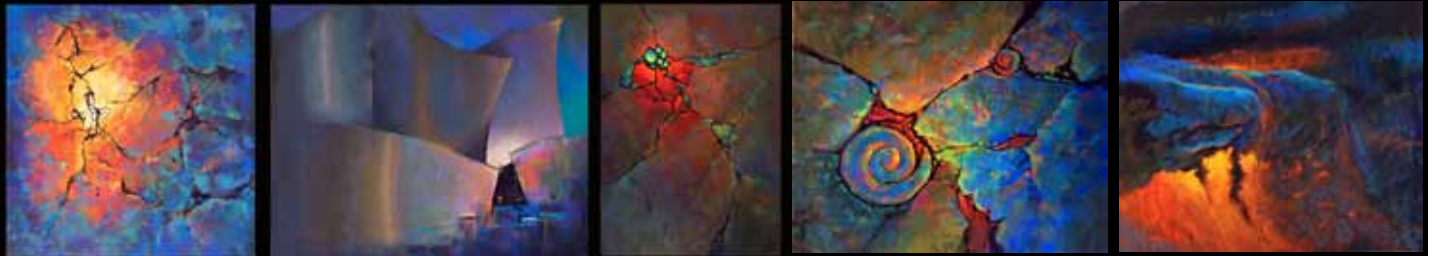
Laura is a Signature Member of the Pastel Society of
