Thursday, October 31: Artists pick up painting(s) between 10 am and 2 pm. Each artist is responsible for picking up his/her painting(s) by 2 p.m. *Storage is not available.*

Preparing Your Paintings

Big Little Paintings is a non-juried exhibition of small works. Maximum size is 320 square inches (height x width = square inch). The maximum size includes the image, mat and frame. A white or off-white mat is optional and is included in the overall maximum size of 320 sq. in.

All paintings will be created with soft pastels; no oil pastels.

Each painting must be framed and wired for hanging.

Entry Process and Fee

All participating artists must be **current members** of Appalachian Pastel Society at the time of entering the show. The membership application is located at the APS website. APS members may enter one painting. However, if space is available, a second entry may be selected.

A photograph (image) of each painting is requested *but not required* for the non-juried show. Submit images by email at the same time the digital entry form is submitted.

Submit image(s) to Anne Allen, annekallen@gmail.com. Name the image: Name_Title_Height x Width_ Medium. Use the unframed size. The subject line of the email with image(s) should read: Artist's LastName_BigLittlePaintings 2019.

Images of paintings to be considered for advanced publicity must be submitted by August 1, 2019.

The APS entry fee is \$12 for up to 2 paintings. Entry fees are non-refundable. Entry fees are paid at the time of delivery on Monday, September 30. Cash or checks payable to Appalachian Pastel Society are accepted.

All artists must attach a label to the back of the frame with the artist's name, title of the painting, and the sales price. If the painting is not for sale, enter NFS on the label.

Artists will review and print the APS liability statement form posted at the APS website. Bring the statement *signed by the artist* and the painting(s) for delivery on Monday, September 30. BlackBird Frame & Art also requires a statement *signed by the artist*. Both liability forms will be posted at the website.

Sales

Prices may not be changed after submission. BlackBird Frame & Art will retain a commission of 40% of the price listed on each work by the artist. Helpful suggestion: enter "pricing artwork" in your computer's browser to review several websites offering tips on pricing artwork.

No painting may be removed before the end of the show.
