
# Artist of the Month - Don Osterberg

## My other life - that of an artist



From as far back as I can remember, drawing and painting has been an important part of my life. Even though my profession was Professor of Biology at the State University of NY, one of my strongest avocations has been art. My artistic experiences include painting (lately en plein air), illustrating, and theatrical lighting and set designs. I have used oil,

acrylic, pen and ink, charcoal, and more recently watercolor and pastel. My favorite topics for painting are landscapes, nature, animals, and still life. I especially enjoy painting light, color and texture in vegetation, sky, and water, with pastel.



I did not sell my paintings until I retired to Hendersonville in 1998. I would give them as gifts or fund raisers or give them to the owners of the subject I had painted. Eventually I realized there was a market for my paintings even though I was not a professional artist, and began to sell them. In the early 2000s when the "depression" set in and the sale of art work took a dive, I decided to buy frames from yard sales, glaze and mat my work myself, and sell my paintings at very reasonable prices. My "tag-line" became <u>Affordable Originals</u>. I have sold paintings in NY State and at the Open Door Bookstore at the Blue Ridge Mall in Hendersonville, NC. I never have been one to enter paintings into competitions, however this past year I was juried into the Art Mob in Hendersonville, where my work is currently available.



I have taken numerous courses and workshops in drawing and painting and I am a member of a number of fine art societies. My work can be found in private collections, educational institutions, and corporate and governmental buildings. I enjoy teaching workshops and doing commissioned work.


