

About Michael Chesley Johnson

Michael paints primarily outdoors in oil, pastel or gouache, choosing locations from the American Southwest, DownEast Maine and the Canadian Maritimes. He has been invited repeatedly to national plein air events such as the *Grand Canyon Celebration of Art*. In May 2022, he will be on the distinguished faculty of the annual *Plein Air Convention & Expo* in Santa Fe.



Michael was awarded Master

Pastelist status by *Pastel Artists Canada* in 2008, and he is a Signature Member of the *American Impressionist Society* and the *Pastel Society of America*. His paintings have appeared in many magazines and are in both corporate and private collections. He was featured in *The Artist's Magazine* in September 2013.

Michael is a nationally known teacher, giving workshops across the U.S.

A frequent writer for *The Artist's Magazine, Pastel Journal, Watercolor Artist* and *Plein Air Magazine,* he is the author of several books, including *Outdoor Study to Studio: Take Your Plein Air Paintings to the Next Level* and *Backpacker Painting: Outdoors with Oil & Pastel.* He is currently at work on a new book featuring some of the top names in the plein air painting arena.

Michael maintains a summer studio on Campobello Island, New Brunswick, Canada, and a winter studio in northern New Mexico. For more visit www.MChesleyJohnson.com.

Michael will be teaching an in-person plein air three-day workshop.

Join nationally-known artist Michael Chesley Johnson as he shows you how to paint the landscape in pastel.

Each day will offer at least one demo plus critiques of student work done in the workshop.

In the plein air painting workshop (in-person workshop), May 30 – June 1, 2022, you'll start with basic principles, and then Michael will demonstrate his method for "capturing the moment" quickly and efficiently but without sacrificing mood and magic. Michael will show you how focusing on just value and color temperature in an initial "best guess" will get you started quickly, leaving plenty of time for making adjustments at a more leisurely pace. After the demonstration, you'll have the opportunity to practice your new skills with Michael going from easel to easel offering plenty of personal help. It will have a maximum of 12 people.
